Mark I. Greene is a partner in the Cravath, Swaine & Moore LLP Corporate Department and is Practice Lead of the International Practice. Mark's practice focuses on mergers and acquisitions, corporate governance and securities matters, including advising on cross-border transactions, private equity deals, complex restructuring transactions, proxy fights, takeover defense and global securities offerings.

Mark is an Adjunct Professor of Law at Cornell Law School, where he teaches a course on Mergers and Acquisitions. He is also Contributing Editor of *Getting the Deal Through: Securities Finance 2009* -- an overview of regulation in 32 jurisdictions worldwide. Additionally, he co-authored the U.S. section of *The Merger and Acquisitions Review*. Mark was one of just 30 lawyers recently named by *The New York Times* as the next generation of deal makers ("The Facebook of Wall Street's Future", *The New York Times*, October 3, 2007). In 2008 and 2009, Mark was recognized by *The Legal 500* for his work in private equity buyouts, and was also cited as being one of the country's leading practitioners in the mergers and acquisitions area in *Chambers USA: America's Leading Lawyers for Business*. He was named by *Lawdragon* magazine as one of 500 leading dealmakers and leading lawyers in America in 2007 and was ranked fifth in 2006 European M&A by *Legal Week* magazine. Mark currently serves as the Co-Chair of the International M&A Joint Venture Committee of the ABA Section of International Law (ABA International).

Mark was born in Neponsit, New York. He received a B.A. from Cornell University in 1989, and a J.D. from the University of Pennsylvania in 1993. After a clerkship with Hon. Charles Legge (U.S. District Court for the Northern District of California), he joined Cravath in 1994 and became a partner in 2001.
