



**DAVID GREENWALD**

David Greenwald is a partner in the Firm's Litigation Department. Mr. Greenwald is a general commercial litigator, whose practice over the past several years has focused on the representation of pharmaceutical companies, biotech companies, and research universities in patent infringement cases. Mr. Greenwald also represents companies and individuals in criminal investigations.

Mr. Greenwald was born in New York, New York. In 1990, he received a B.A., *summa cum laude* (biochemical sciences) from Harvard College, where he was elected to Phi Beta Kappa. In 1993, Mr. Greenwald received a J.D. with high honors from the University of Chicago, where he was an editor of the Law Review, the recipient of the D. Francis Bustin Prize, and was elected to the Order of the Coif.

Mr. Greenwald first joined Cravath during the summer of 1992. Following a clerkship with Hon. Richard A. Posner (Chief Judge, U.S. Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit), Mr. Greenwald returned to Cravath in 1994. In 1997, he left to join the U.S. Attorney's Office, Southern District of New York, Criminal Division, where he served as an Assistant U.S. Attorney and successfully represented the government in trials and appeals. In 2000, Mr. Greenwald returned to Cravath, and became a partner in 2005. At Cravath, Mr. Greenwald oversees the Litigation Department's Continuing Legal Education program, where he regularly lectures about various legal and ethical topics.

Between 2000 and 2003, Mr. Greenwald served on the Professional and Judicial Ethics Committee of the Association of the Bar of the City of New York. Between 1996 and 2008, Mr. Greenwald was a member of the Lawyers' Orchestra of the Association of the Bar of the City of New York, which he founded. Mr. Greenwald presently serves as a trustee and Treasurer of the French-American School of Music.
